

DEMONSTRATIONS AND DISORDERS

Most demonstrations are lawful. The United States Supreme Court adopted a standard which says that a demonstration is permitted as long as it does not materially disrupt class work, or involve substantial disorder, or invade the rights of others. However, any demonstration on the campus that is unruly or interferes with normal activities is unlawful.

- A. In the event of an unlawful demonstration, the following guidelines will be followed to ensure the safety of students, faculty and staff.
 - 1. Notify Campus Police (325-2121) and your administrative chain.
 - 2. All occupants should remain in their offices or classrooms.

- B. The Vice President of Student Affairs (325-3045) or designee should be informed immediately of the situation.
